## PART 6

## WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION

Supplemental provisions relating to sections 47 and 50

## 55 Consent to prosecutions

Proceedings for an offence under section 47 or 50 shall not be instituted-

- (a) in England and Wales, except by or with the consent of the Attorney General;
- (b) in Northern Ireland, except by or with the consent of the [<sup>F1</sup>Advocate General for Northern Ireland].
