FURTHER PROVISION ABOUT STANDING ADVISORY COMMITTEES

- 1 Regulations may make provision with respect to—
 - (a) the appointment,
 - (b) the tenure of office [F1(including removal or suspension from office)], and
 - (c) the vacation of office,

of the members of any standing advisory committee.

- 4 Any such sub-committee may include persons who are not members of the standing advisory committee.
- Each standing advisory committee must elect one of the members of the committee to be chairman of the committee.
