



# Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1953

1953 CHAPTER 47 1 and 2 Eliz 2

## 12 Provisions as to orders.

- (1) Any power conferred by this Act on the Secretary of State . . . <sup>F1</sup> to make an order shall be construed as including a power to revoke or vary the order by a subsequent order.
- (2) Any power conferred by this Act on the Secretary of State . . . <sup>F1</sup> to make an order shall be exercisable by statutory instrument.
- (3) A statutory instrument containing an order under section three, . . . <sup>F1</sup> or eight of this Act shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
