#### *Courts-martial: provisions relating to trial*

#### 97 Finding and sentence.

(1) Without prejudice to the provisions of section ninety-four of this Act, the finding of a court-martial on each charge shall be announced in open court.

(3) Any sentence of a court-martial, together with any recommendation to mercy [<sup>F2</sup>and any reasons for the sentence], shall be announced in open court, <sup>F3</sup>. . .
