- (2) All rights and liabilities of the Treasury under any agreement made before the commencement of this Act for the making by them of an advance under the said Part I for the construction or improvement of a harbour in England and Wales shall, by virtue of this subsection, vest in [^{F3}the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food], and all rights and liabilities of the Treasury under any agreement so made for the making by them of an advance under the said Part I for the construction or improvement of a harbour in Scotland shall, by virtue of this subsection, vest in the Secretary of State.
- (3) Subsection (3) of the last foregoing section shall apply to any loan in respect of which rights and liabilities of the Treasury vest in [^{F3}the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food] or the Secretary of State by virtue of the last foregoing subsection as it applies to a loan made under that section by that Minister or the Secretary of State, as the case may be.]
