



Geneva Conventions Act 1957

1957 CHAPTER 52 5 and 6 Eliz 2

U.K.

An Act to enable effect to be given to certain international conventions done at Geneva on the twelfth day of August, nineteen hundred and forty-nine, and for purposes connected therewith. [31st July 1957]

Whereas, with a view to the ratification by Her Majesty of the conventions set out in the Schedules to this Act, it is expedient to make certain amendments in the law:
