HOUSE OF COMMONS MEMBERS' FUND ACT 1948 (REPEALED)

- 1 Payments to widowers of past members.
- 2 Increase of annual payments to past members, widows and children.
- 3 Variation of maximum payments and deductions from members' salaries.
- 4 Provision for cases of special hardship.
- 5 Acceptance of property by the trustees.
- 6 Report by Government Actuary.
- 7 Citation.
