CHAPTER 118

COURT OF SESSION (NO. 2) ACT 1838

- Junior Lord Ordinary to act as one of the permanent Lords Ordinary.
- II Actions of Reduction to be enrolled before any Lord Ordinary.
 - III Causes to be enrolled weekly before any Lord Ordinary.
 - IV Lords Ordinary to be attached to, either Division.
 - V Principal Clerks of Session.
 - VI Vacancies of Principal Jury Clerks not to be filled up. Distribution of Duties of Issue Clerks.
 - VII Distribution of Duties of Record Clerks.
 - VIII Duties of Principal Clerks may be discharged in his Absence by other Clerks.
 - IX Office of Clerk of Queen's Processes abolished.
 - X Assistant Clerks in the Inner House.
 - XI Duties of Assistant Clerks.
 - XII Depute Clerks in the Outer House, and Assistants.
 - XIII Salaries of Assistant Clerks in the Outer House.
 - XIV Two Clerks of the Bill Chamber.
 - XV Distribution of Business of the Court.
 - XVI Judges Clerks and Keepers of Inner and Outer House Rolls.
 - XVII Annuity Fund to Judges Clerks and Keepers of Inner House Rolls.
 - XVIII Extractors.
 - XIX Salary of Extractors. Ingrossing Clerks.
 - XX Keeper of the Records.
 - XXI Keeper of the Minute Book and Record of Edictal Citations.
 - XXII Minute Book how to be printed.
 - XXIII Collector and Accountant of the Fee Fund.
 - XXIV Auditor to be paid by Salary.
 - XXV Macers.
 - XXVI Teind Clerks.
