



# Judicial Trustees Act 1896

1896 CHAPTER 35 59 and 60 Vict

## 2 Court to exercise jurisdiction.

The jurisdiction of the court under this Act may be exercised by the High Court, . . . <sup>F1</sup>, and (subject to the prescribed definition of the jurisdiction) by any county court judge to whom such jurisdiction may be assigned under this Act.
