**FUGITIVE CRIMINAL**

**The Extradition (Hijacking) (Amendment) Order 1987**

*Made* - - - - 26th November 1987  
*Laid before Parliament* 4th December 1987  
*Coming into force* - - 1st January 1988

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 26th day of November 1987

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by sections 2, 17 and 21 of the Extradition Act 1870(1) and sections 9(2) and 39(1) of the Aviation Security Act 1982(2), or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Extradition (Hijacking) (Amendment) Order 1987 and shall come into force on 1st January 1988.

2. The Extradition (Hijacking) Order 1971(3) shall be amended by adding to Part I of Schedule 3 (which names the foreign States with which the United Kingdom has no extradition treaties in force and which are parties to the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Seizure of Aircraft signed at The Hague on 16th December 1970(4)) the following entry —
