**1990 No. 1828**

**The Zebra Pedestrian Crossings (Amendment) Regulations 1990**

3. In Part II of Schedule 2 after paragraph 3 there shall be added—
  - “4. Subject to paragraphs 5 and 6, a globe may be fitted with—
    - (a) a backing board designed to improve the conspicuity of the globe;
    - (b) a shield designed to prevent or reduce light from the globe shining into adjacent properties; or
    - (c) such a board and shield.
  5. If a backing board or shield is fitted to a globe it shall—
    - (a) be firmly secured;
    - (b) not prevent any driver of a vehicle proceeding towards the zebra crossing in question from seeing the globe; and
    - (c) not constitute a danger to any user of the road.
  6. Any backing board shall be coloured black and may have a white border.”
