The District Probate Registries (Amendment) Order 1994

Made - - - - 18th April 1994
Laid before Parliament 25th April 1994
Coming into force - - 23rd May 1994

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 104 of the Supreme Court Act 1981(1), hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the District Probate Registries (Amendment) Order 1994 and shall come into force on 23rd May 1994.
- **2.** The Gloucester Probate Sub—Registry shall be attached to and under the control of the registrar of the Oxford District Probate Registry, instead of the Llandaff District Probate Registry.
- **3.** Column 2 of the Schedule to the District Probate Registries Order 1982(**2**) shall accordingly be amended as follows—
- (1) in the entry appearing opposite to the entry in column 1 relating to the Llandaff District Probate Registry (Probate Registry of Wales), the word "Gloucester" and the comma which precedes it shall be omitted; and
- (2) in the entry appearing opposite to the entry in column 1 relating to the Oxford District Probate Registry, before the word "Leicester" there shall be inserted the word "Gloucester" followed by a comma.
