The Criminal Justice Act 1988(Crown Servants) Regulations 1994

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 93G(1) of the Criminal Justice Act 1988(1), I hereby make the following Regulations:

Title and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Justice Act 1988 (Crown Servants) Regulations 1994 and shall come into force on 1st August 1994.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations—

"the 1988 Act" means the Criminal Justice Act 1988; and

"relevant financial business" has the meaning given by regulation 4 of the Money Laundering Regulations 1993(2).

Application of the Act to Director of Savings and staff

3. Sections 93A, 93B, 93C(2) and 93D of the 1988 Act(**3**)shall apply to the following persons, namely—

- (a) the Director of Savings; and
- (b) any person employed by or otherwise engaged in the service of the Director of Savings,
