The National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1994

Amendment of Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations

5. Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations (diseases for the treatment of which no charge is to be made) shall be amended by—

- (a) inserting after the entry for Leptospirosis an entry for Lyme disease;
- (b) inserting after the entry for Tetanus an entry for Toxoplasmosis; and
- (c) substituting for the entry for Viral haemorrhagic fever an entry for Viral haemorrhagic fevers⁽¹⁾.

(1) This entry covers, amongst others, Argentine haemorrhagic fever (Junin), Bolivian haemorrhagic fever (Machupo), Chikungunya haemorrhagic fever, Congo/Crimean haemorrhagic fever, Dengue fever, Ebola virus disease, haemorrhagic fever with renal syndrome (Hantaan), Kyasanur forest disease, Lassa fever, Marburg disease, Omsk haemorrhagic fever, Rift Valley disease and Yellow fever.
