# The Social Security (Recovery of Benefits) Act 1997 (Commencement) Order 1997

*Made - - - - 1st September 1997* 

The Secretary of State for Social Security, in exercise of the power conferred upon her by section 34(2) of the Social Security (Recovery of Benefits) Act 1997(1), hereby makes the following Order:

#### Citation and interpretation

- **1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Social Security (Recovery of Benefits) Act 1997 (Commencement) Order 1997.
  - (2) In this Order, "the 1997 Act" means the Social Security (Recovery of Benefits) Act 1997.

### Appointed days

**2.**—(1) The following provisions of the 1997 Act shall come into force on 3rd September 1997 for the purpose of conferring on the Secretary of State the powers to make regulations:

(2) The 1997 Act to the extent it is not already in force shall come into force on 6th October 1997.
