Having consulted in accordance with section 32(5) of the Justices of the Peace Act 1997⁽¹⁾, the Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 32(3) and (8) of that Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Magistrates' Courts Committees (Merseyside) Amalgamation (Amendment) Order 1998 and shall come into force on 1st June 1998.

2. In paragraph 1 of the Schedule to the Magistrates' Courts Committees (Merseyside) Amalgamation Order 1998⁽²⁾:—

- (a) in the definition of “the first appointed day”, for “June” there shall be substituted “July”;
- (b) in the definition of “the second appointed day”, for “July” there shall be substituted “August”.
