**The Outer Space Act 1986 (Fees)
(Amendment) Regulations 1998**

Made - - - - 14th August 1998
Laid before Parliament 19th August 1998
Coming into force - - 30th September 1998

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 4(3)(d) and 11 of the Outer Space Act 1986⁽¹⁾, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Outer Space Act 1986 (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1998 and shall come into force on 30 September 1998.

2. Paragraph (2) of regulation 3 of the Outer Space Act 1986 (Fees) Regulations 1989⁽²⁾ is amended by substituting the sum of £6,500 for the sum of £1,000 specified in that paragraph.
