EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend regulation 10 of the Education (Schools and Further Education) Regulations 1981 ("the 1981 Regulations").

Paragraph (2) is amended so that the reference is now to a school to which the 1981 Regulations apply meeting for at least 380 sessions in each school year, rather than in each academic year. This brings the 1981 Regulations into line with section 551 of the Education Act 1996 which refers to the duration of the school year rather than the academic year.

These Regulations make special provision in respect of the training of teachers at schools situated in England. Where, in the 1998/99 school year, one or more school sessions are devoted on or after 1st May to the training of teachers in the teaching of literacy or numeracy for pupils in the first or second key stage, then a maximum of two of those sessions are to be treated for the purposes of the 1981 Regulations (in particular the requirement that the school meet for no fewer than 380 sessions) as being sessions on which the school has met.
