The Building Societies Act 1997 (Expiry of Transitional Period) Order 1998

Made - - - - *18th November 1998*

The Building Societies Commission, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by paragraph 2(7) of Schedule 8 to the Building Societies Act 1997(1) hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Building Societies Act 1997 (Expiry of Transitional Period) Order 1998.

(2) In this Order "the transitional period" means the period defined in paragraphs 2(7) and 3(6) of Schedule 8 to the Building Societies Act 1997 as beginning with the commencement of sections 1 and 2 of the Building Societies Act 1997 on 1st December 1997(2) and expiring with such day as the Commission, with the consent of the Treasury, prescribes by order made by statutory instrument.

Expiry of transitional period

2. The transitional period shall expire on 30th April 1999.
