The Leicester College (Incorporation) Order 1999

Whereas the Secretary of State for Education and Employment has received a proposal from the Further Education Funding Council for England, made in accordance with section 51 of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992(1) (“the Act”), for the establishment of a body corporate under section 16(1)(a) of the Act;

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 16(1) and 17 of the Act and for the purpose of giving effect to that proposal, the Secretary of State hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Leicester College (Incorporation) Order 1999, and shall come into force on 1st April 1999 (“the Commencement Date”).

2. On the Commencement Date there shall be established a body corporate called “Leicester College” for the purpose of establishing and conducting from the operative date a new educational institution of that name (to be formed by the merger of Charles Keene College of Further Education, Leicester and Leicester South Fields College).

3. The “operative date” in relation to the further education corporation established by this Order shall be 1st August 1999, and the corporation shall conduct Leicester College from that date.
