**CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSONS, ENGLAND**

**The Children (Leaving Care) (England) Regulations 2001**

*Made* - - - - *8th August 2001*  
*Laid before Parliament* *8th August 2001*  
*Coming into force* - - *1st October 2001*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 23A(3), 23B(5), (6), (8) (c), (10), 23D(2), 23E, 24B(6), 24D(2) and 104(4) of, and paragraphs 19B(2), (3), (7) and (8) of Schedule 2 to, the Children Act 1989<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Paragraph 19B of Schedule 2 is inserted by section 1 of the 2000 Act. The functions of the Secretary of State under these provisions in respect of Wales are transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by article 2 of the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672), and section 8(7) of the 2000 Act. See section 105(1) of the Act for the definition of “prescribed”.
