Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security and Child Support (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 2) Regulations 2003 and shall come into force on 4th May 2003.

Revocation

2. Regulation 6 of the Social Security and Child Support (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2003(3) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Social Security and Child Support (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2003 ("the Miscellaneous Amendments Regulations") which contained no express commencement date for regulation 6.

Regulation 2 revokes regulation 6 of the Miscellaneous Amendments Regulations.
