**The Natural History Museum  
(Authorised Repositories) Order 2006**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10(2) of the British Museum Act 1963<sup>(1)</sup> and now vested in her <sup>(2)</sup>, with the agreement of the Trustees of the Natural History Museum, makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Natural History Museum (Authorised Repositories) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 10th July 2006.

**2.** At the end of paragraph 1 of Part 2 of Schedule 3 to the British Museum Act 1963<sup>(3)</sup> insert “, but excluding the part of that site known as the “Central Boiler House” and located on the north side of the Natural History Museum“.
