**The Pensions Act 2004 (Code of Practice) (Modification of subsisting rights) Appointed Day Order 2007**

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order appoints the day for the purposes of section 91(9) of the Pensions Act 2004 (c.35) (procedure for issue and publication of codes of practice) for the coming into effect of the Pensions Regulator Code of Practice No. 10: Modification of subsisting rights as 24th January 2007.

An assessment of the impact on business, charities or the voluntary sector of the provisions relating to modification of subsisting rights was included in the Regulatory Impact Assessment that accompanied the Pensions Act 2004.
