Judicial review proceedings in the Upper Tribunal

[F1Special provisions for [F2immigration judicial review] proceedings

- **28A.**—(1) The Upper Tribunal must not accept an application for permission to bring [F3immigration judicial review] proceedings unless it is either accompanied by any required fee or the Upper Tribunal accepts an undertaking that the fee will be paid.
- (2) Within 9 days of making an application referred to in paragraph (1), an applicant must provide—
 - (a) a copy of the application and any accompanying documents to each person named in the application as a respondent or an interested party; and
 - (b) the Upper Tribunal with a written statement of when and how this was done.]
