## **CUSTOMS**

The Export Control (Uzbekistan) (Amendment) Order 2009

Made - - - - 6th May 2009
Laid before Parliament 7th May 2009
Coming into force - - 8th May 2009

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 7 of the Export Control Act 2002(1), makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Export Control (Uzbekistan) (Amendment) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 8th May 2009.
  - 2.—(1) The Export Control (Uzbekistan) Order 2005(2) is amended as follows.
- (2) In Article 1(2), in the definition of "the Regulation" after the words "14 November 2005" insert "as amended by Council Regulation (EC) No 154/2009 of 23 February 2009(3)".

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This Order implements in part Council Regulation (EC) No 154/2009 ("the Regulation") which amends Council Regulation (EC) No 1859/2005 ("the Original Regulation")(4).

The Regulation replaces Annex I of the Original Regulation. Annex I lists equipment which might be used for internal repression.

A full regulatory impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as it has minimal impact on the costs of business.
