Polygraph session requirements E+W

- **6.**—(1) [F1Before each polygraph session, an employee of the probation provider] must explain to the relevant offender—
 - (a) the requirements of and arrangements for the polygraph session; and
 - (b) that anything disclosed during the session may be communicated to the probation provider responsible for that relevant offender's supervision.
- (2) Before [F2the relevant offender's first polygraph session, an employee of the probation provider] must [F3ask for] written confirmation from the relevant offender that the matters in paragraph (1) above have been explained and that the relevant offender has understood that explanation.
- [^{F4}(3) An employee of the probation provider must attach that written confirmation to the relevant offender's case record.]
