The Polygraph Rules 2009

Polygraph session requirements **E+W**

6.—(1) [^{F1}Before each polygraph session, an employee of the probation provider] must explain to the relevant offender—

- (a) the requirements of and arrangements for the polygraph session; and
- (b) that anything disclosed during the session may be communicated to the probation provider responsible for that relevant offender's supervision.

(2) Before [^{F2}the relevant offender's first polygraph session, an employee of the probation provider] must [^{F3}ask for] written confirmation from the relevant offender that the matters in paragraph (1) above have been explained and that the relevant offender has understood that explanation.

[^{F4}(3) An employee of the probation provider must attach that written confirmation to the relevant offender's case record.]
