**The Criminal Justice and Police
Act 2001 (Amendment) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 30th May 2012

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1(2) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001(1).

A draft of this Order has been laid before and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 (Amendment) Order 2012.

(2) This Order shall come into force one month after the day on which it is made.

Amendment of section 1(1) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001

2. In the Table in section 1(1) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001(2), before the entry relating to section 55 of the British Transport Commission Act 1949(3) insert—

“Section 2(1) of the Parks Regulation Failing to comply with, or contravening, those (Amendment) Act 1926(4) so far as it creates Regulations by—
an offence against the Parks Regulation Act 1872(5) relating to any of the following provisions of the Royal Parks and Other Open Spaces Regulations 1997 (S.I. 1997/1639)—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Table in section 1(1) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 (c.16) to add further offences in respect of which a penalty notice may be given. The offences are littering, dog fouling or cycling in the Royal Parks.

A full impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as it has no impact on the private or voluntary sectors.
