The Personal Independence Payment (Transitional Provisions) (Amendment) Regulations 2013

The Secretary of State for Work and Pensions, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 93 and 94(1) and (2) of, and paragraphs 1(1) and 3(1)(a) and (b) of Schedule 10 to, the Welfare Reform Act 2012⁽¹⁾, makes the following Regulations.

The Secretary of State has not referred proposals in respect of these Regulations to the Social Security Advisory Committee, as it appears to him that by reason of the urgency of the matter it is inexpedient to do so⁽²⁾.
