The Criminal Legal Aid (General) Regulations 2013

Interpretation and General

Delegation

4. A function of the Lord Chancellor or Director⁽¹⁾ under these Regulations may be exercised by, or by an employee of, a person authorised for that purpose by the Lord Chancellor or Director respectively⁽²⁾.
