**ENERGY CONSERVATION**

**The Ecodesign for Energy-Related Products and  
Energy Information (Amendment) Regulations 2015**

*Made - - - - 2nd March 2015*  
*Laid before Parliament 4th March 2015*  
*Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1*

The Secretary of State is a Minister designated<sup>(1)</sup> for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972<sup>(2)</sup> in relation to the environmental aspects of product design and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by that section.

**Citation and commencement**

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Ecodesign for Energy-Related Products and Energy Information (Amendment) Regulations 2015.

(2) Subject to paragraph (3), these Regulations come into force on 1st July 2015.

(3) Regulations 2(3) and 3 come into force on 1st January 2016.

**Amendment of the Ecodesign for Energy-Related Products Regulations 2010**

2.—(1) The table at paragraph 4 of Schedule 1 (declaration of conformity) to the Ecodesign for Energy-Related Products Regulations 2010<sup>(3)</sup> is amended as follows.

(2) After item 22 insert—

### **Amendment of the Energy Information Regulations 2011**

**3.**—(1) The table at Schedule 1 (EU measures) to the Energy Information Regulations 2011<sup>(6)</sup> is amended as follows.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the Ecodesign for Energy-Related Products Regulations 2010 ([S.I. 2010/2617](#)) (“the 2010 Regulations”) and the Energy Information Regulations 2011 ([S.I. 2011/1524](#)) (“the 2011 Regulations”) and partially implement Commission Regulations (EU) Nos 548/2014 and 1253/2014, and Commission Delegated Regulations (EU) No 1254/2014 as follows—

- (a) regulation 2(2) and (3) adds two new products to Schedule 1 (declaration of conformity) to the 2010 Regulations—
  - (i) small, medium and large power transformers to apply from 1st July 2015;
  - (ii) ventilation units to apply from 1st January 2016; and
- (b) regulation 3 adds residential ventilation units to Schedule 1 (EU measures) to the 2011 Regulations to apply from 1st January 2016.

A full regulatory impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no impact on the private or voluntary sectors is foreseen.
