The Cultural Property (Armed Conflicts) Act  
2017 (Commencement) Regulations 2017

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the power conferred by section 32(2) of the Cultural Property (Armed Conflicts) Act 2017<sup>(1)</sup>, makes the following Regulations:

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Cultural Property (Armed Conflicts) Act 2017 (Commencement) Regulations 2017.

**Appointed day**

2. The day appointed for the coming into force of those provisions of the Cultural Property (Armed Conflicts) Act 2017 that are not already in force is 12th December 2017.
