**The Teachers' Pensions (Miscellaneous
Provisions) (Amendment) Regulations 2021**

Made - - - - 6th July 2021

Laid before Parliament 8th July 2021

Coming into force - - 1st August 2021

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers in sections 9 and 12 of, and Schedule 3 to, the Superannuation Act 1972(1) (“the 1972 Act”).

The Secretary of State also makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers in sections 2 and 3 of, paragraph 4(a) of Schedule 2 to, and Schedule 3 to, the Public Service Pensions Act 2013(2) (“the 2013 Act”).

The Secretary of State has carried out the consultations referred to in section 9(5) of the 1972 Act and section 21(1) of the 2013 Act.

In accordance with section 9(1) of the 1972 Act and section 3(5) of the 2013 Act, these Regulations are made with the consent of the Treasury.
