# The Office of Communications (Membership) (Modification) Order 2022

Made - - - - 11th October 2022

Laid before Parliament 13th October 2022

Coming into force - - 3rd November 2022

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the power conferred by section 1(7) of the Office of Communications Act 2002(1), makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Office of Communications (Membership) (Modification) Order 2022 and comes into force on 3rd November 2022.

#### Modification of maximum number of members

2. In section 1(2) of the Office of Communications Act 2002 for "twelve" substitute "thirteen" (2).

#### Revocation

3. The Office of Communications (Membership) (Modification) Order 2016 is revoked.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order increases the maximum membership of the Office of Communications from twelve to thirteen.

Article 2 amends section 1(2) of the Office of Communications Act 2002 to increase the maximum number stated in that section to thirteen.

Article 3 revokes the previous Order which modified the maximum number of members.

A full impact assessment has not been produced for this Order as no impact on the private, voluntary or public sectors is foreseen.
