The A47 Wansford to Sutton (Corrections) Order 2023

Made - - - - *16th June 2023*

Coming into force - - *17th June 2023*

The A47 Wansford to Sutton Development Consent Order 2023 (“the 2023 Order”)(**1**), which granted development consent within the meaning of the Planning Act 2008 (“the Act”)(**2**), contained correctable errors within the meaning of the Act.

In accordance with paragraph 1(5)(a) of Schedule 4 to the Act, before the end of the relevant period, as defined in paragraph 1(6)(a) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Secretary of State received a written request from the applicant(**3**) for the correction of errors in the 2023 Order.

In accordance with paragraph 1(7) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Secretary of State has informed the relevant local planning authorities for the area in which the land to which the 2023 Order relates is situated, that the request has been received in accordance with paragraph 1(7) of Schedule 4 to the Act.

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 119 of, and paragraph 1(4) and (8) of Schedule 4 to, the Act, makes the following Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A47 Wansford to Sutton (Corrections) Order 2023 and comes into force on 17th June 2023.

Corrections to the 2023 Order

2.—(1) The A47 Wansford to Sutton Development Consent Order 2023 is corrected as set out in the table in the Schedule to this Order, where—
