**The Education Maintenance Allowances  
(Wales) (Revocation) Regulations 2009**

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the National Assembly for Wales by section 181 of the Education Act 2002<sup>(1)</sup> and now exercisable by them<sup>(2)</sup>, make the following Regulations:

**Title, commencement and application**

1.—(1) The title of these Regulations is the Education Maintenance Allowances (Wales) (Revocation) Regulations 2009.

(2) These Regulations come into force on 24 April 2009 and apply in relation to Wales.

**Revocation**

2. The Education Maintenance Allowances (Wales) Regulations 2007<sup>(3)</sup> are revoked.
