**The Apprenticeships (Designation of Welsh
Certifying Authority) (Amendment) Order 2015**

Coming into force - - 16 October 2015

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 10(1)(b) and (3) of the Apprenticeships, Skills, Children and Learning Act 2009(1), make the following Order:

Title, commencement and application

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the Apprenticeships (Designation of Welsh Certifying Authority) (Amendment) Order 2015 and it comes into force on 16 October 2015.

(2) This Order applies in relation to Wales.

Amendment of the Apprenticeships (Designation of Welsh Certifying Authority) Order 2013

2.—(1) The Apprenticeships (Designation of Welsh Certifying Authority) Order 2013(2) is amended as follows.

(2) In article 2 for the words “the Alliance of Sector Skills Councils” substitute “the Federation for Industry Sector Skills & Standards (Company Number: SC175918)”.
