**The Relaxation of School Reporting Requirements
(Wales) (Coronavirus) Regulations 2022**

The Welsh Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by sections 537 and 569(4) of the Education Act 1996⁽¹⁾, and now vested in them⁽²⁾, and in exercise of the powers conferred on the National Assembly for Wales by sections 30(1) and 210(7) of the Education Act 2002⁽³⁾ and now vested in them⁽⁴⁾, make the following Regulations:

- (2) The functions of the Secretary of State under these sections were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 ([S.I. 1999/672](#)) and then to the Welsh Ministers under paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 ([c. 32](#)).
