The Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees) (Amendment) Order 1999

The Chancellor of the Exchequer, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(1) and (2) of, and paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 3 to, the Public Expenditure and Receipts Act 1968(1) and now vested in him(2) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order–

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees) (Amendment) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 1st June 1999.

- (2) In this Order–
 - (a) the "1998 Order" means the Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees) Order 1998(3); and
 - (b) a reference to a numbered column is to the column in the Schedule to the 1998 Order bearing that number.
