**The Bournemouth Primary Care Trust
(Change of Name) Amendment Order 2003**

Made - - - - *13th October 2003*

Coming into force - - *4th November 2003*

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 16A(1) and (2) and 126(3) of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 5A to, the National Health Service Act 1977(1), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Bournemouth Primary Care Trust (Change of Name) Amendment Order 2003 and shall come into force on 4th November 2003.

(2) In this Order—

“the Establishment Order” means the Bournemouth Primary Care Trust (Establishment) Order 2000(2); and

“the trust” means the Primary Care Trust established by the Establishment Order.

Change of name of the trust

2. The trust shall be called the Bournemouth Teaching Primary Care Trust instead of the Bournemouth Primary Care Trust, and accordingly—

(a) in article 1(2) of the Establishment Order (citation, commencement and interpretation), in the definition of “the trust”; and

(b) in article 2 of the Establishment Order (establishment and name of the Primary Care Trust), “Bournemouth” shall be replaced by “Bournemouth Teaching”.

The functions of the Secretary of State under these provisions are, so far as exercisable in relation to Wales, transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by article 2(a) of the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999, S.I. 1999/672, as amended by section 66(5) of the 1999 Act.

3. The change of name effected by article 2 of this Order shall not—

(a) affect any right or obligation of any person; or

(b) be taken as invalidating any instrument (whether made before, on, or after the day on which this Order comes into force) which refers to the trust by its previous name,

and all instruments and other documents which refer to the trust under its previous name shall be construed as referring to it under its new name.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Bournemouth Primary Care Trust (Establishment) Order 2000, which established the Bournemouth Primary Care Trust.

Article 2 of the Order changes the name of the trust from the Bournemouth Primary Care Trust to the Bournemouth Teaching Primary Care Trust, and makes consequential amendments to the Establishment Order.
