The Lord Chancellor makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 107(6) of the Constitutional Reform Act 2005(1)—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Permitted Persons (Designation) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 3rd April 2006.
