

COUNCIL DECISION

of 30 June 1969

adopting a research programme for the continuation of the 'Dragon' Project

(69/205/Euratom)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community, and in particular Article 7 thereof;

Having regard to the Treaty establishing a Single Council and a Single Commission of the European Communities;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission, which consulted the Scientific and Technical Committee;

Whereas the Community is interested in continued participation in the 'Dragon' Project and whereas a decision in this connection is a matter of urgency;

Article 1

For the period from 1 April 1970 to 31 March 1973, a research programme which shall include the continued participation of the Community in the work covered by the 'Agreement for the Further Extension of the Revised Agreement concerning the High-temperature Gas-cooled Reactor Project (Dragon)' shall be adopted.

Article 2

The financial obligations in respect of that programme shall not exceed 6.9 million units of account.
