COMMISSION DECISION

of 18 December 1975

on the amount of the reimbursement by the Community of the expenditure incurred by the Italian Republic in implementing the 1970/71 programme of the Food Aid Convention of 1967

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2052/69 of 17 October 1969 on the Community financing of expenditure arising from the implementation of the Food Aid Convention (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1703/72 (2), and in particular Article 6 thereof,

Having regard to the application for reimbursement by the Italian Republic,

Having consulted the EAGGF Committee,

Whereas Article 6 of Regulation (EEC) No 2052/69 requires the Commission to determine the amount of reimbursement for all Community measures under each yearly aid programme on the basis of the statements of expense submitted by the Member States;

Whereas these statements have been forwarded to the Commission for this purpose in respect of the 1970/71 programme adopted by the Council;

Whereas the Italian Republic has taken part under this programme in Community food-aid measures by providing cereals for the International Committee of the Red Cross, Indonesia, Pakistan, Tunisia and Turkey; Whereas the amount of reimbursement in question is based on the value of the cereals supplied and the appropriate forwarding cost; whereas the financing of these measures is ensured under Chapter 92, 'Food Aid', of the budget of the European Communities,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The amount of the reimbursement by the Community of the expenditure incurred by the Italian Republic in implementing the 1970/71 programme of the Food Aid Convention of 1967 shall be Lit 4 050 970 714, i.e. 6 481 553·14 units of account.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the Italian Republic.
