

Commission Decision of 25 May 1994 laying down detailed rules for the application of Article 9 (1) of Council Directive 90/425/EEC concerning veterinary and zootechnical checks applicable in intra-Community trade in certain live animals and products with a view to the completion of the internal market (94/339/EC)

Article 1

- 1 The notification referred to in the first subparagraph of Article 9 (1) of Directive 90/425/EEC must be carried out directly in writing and by the most expeditious.
- 2 The notification referred to in paragraph 1 includes:
 - a copy of the health certificate and, if necessary, the number and description of the animals in the consignment;
 - the date of arrival of the consignment at the place of destination;
 - the date of collection of the samples and the date on which the laboratory test has been carried out, if samples were taken or, if no samples were taken, the date of which the check has been carried out;
 - the nature of the results of the check and, if samples were taken, the description of the animals tested, the nature of the test carried out on the samples and the results of that test.
