

Commission Decision of 15 April 2004 authorising methods for grading pig carcasses in the United Kingdom (notified under document number C(2004) 1340) (Only the English text is authentic) (2004/370/EC)

Article 4

Notwithstanding the standard presentation referred to in Article 2(1) of Regulation (EEC) No 3220/84, the flare fat, the kidneys and the diaphragm need not be removed from pig carcasses before being weighed and graded. In order to establish quotations for pig carcasses on a comparable basis, the recorded hot weight shall be reduced:

- for pig carcasses up to 56 kg, by 0,7 kg
- for pig carcasses from 56,5 to 74,5 kg, by 1,1 kg
- for pig carcasses of 75 kg and over, by 1,6 kg.

Changes to legislation:
