Commission Decision of 2 September 2004 on the list of establishments in New Caledonia from which Member States may authorise importation of fresh meat into the Community (notified under document number C(2004) 3296) (Text with EEA relevance) (2004/628/EC)

Article 1

The establishments in New Caledonia listed in the Annex are hereby approved as establishments from which Member States may authorise the importation of fresh meat into the Community pursuant to the conditions laid down in Directive 72/462/EEC, including Article 18(1)(a) and (b) thereof.

Article 2

This Decision shall apply from 6 September 2004.

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
