

Commission Decision of 21 January 2005 authorising Member States temporarily to provide for derogations from certain provisions of Council Directive 2000/29/EC in respect of the importation of soil contaminated by pesticides or persistent organic pollutants for decontamination purposes (notified under document number C(2005) 92) (2005/51/EC)

- Article A1 In this Decision: ‘contaminated soil’ means: soil contaminated by pesticides...
- Article 1 (1.) The competent authorities may authorise the introduction into Great...
- Article 2 Member States shall provide the Commission and the other Member...

- Article 4 This Decision may be revoked if the conditions set out...
- Article 5 This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
