- (a) the meat products and/or treated stomachs, bladders and intestines must:
 - (i) contain meat and/or meat products derived from a single species or animal, as [FI indicated by the code "AP" in] the relevant column in Parts 2 and 3 of Annex II indicating the species or animal concerned; and
 - (ii) [F2have undergone any specific treatment, as set out in Part 4 of Annex 2, for meat of that species or animal that the Secretary of State, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers (in relation to Scotland) and the Welsh Ministers (in relation to Wales), may specify in a document published for the purposes of this point;]
- (b) the meat products and/or treated stomachs, bladders and intestines must:
