

COMMISSION DECISION
of 29 October 2012
on extending the availability period of the European Union macro-financial assistance to Bosnia and Herzegovina
(2012/674/EU)

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Decision 2009/891/EC of 30 November 2009 providing macro-financial assistance to Bosnia and Herzegovina ⁽¹⁾, and in particular to Article 1(4),

Whereas:

- (1) The availability of the European Union macro-financial assistance to Bosnia and Herzegovina, according to the above mentioned Decision 2009/891/EC, expires on 7 November 2012.
- (2) Article 1(4) of Decision 2009/891/EC foresees the possibility for the Commission to extend the availability period by a maximum of one year.
- (3) The availability period should be extended by one year in order to complete the financial assistance programme.

- (4) The Economic and Financial Committee has been duly consulted on this extension,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The availability period of the macro-financial assistance to Bosnia and Herzegovina is extended by one additional year, until 7 November 2013.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
